Prejudice

A state of mind; a set of attitudes held, consciously or unconsciously, often in the absence of legitimate or sufficient evidence; means literally to “pre-judge”; considered irrational and very resistant to change, because concrete evidence that contradicts the prejudice is usually dismissed as exceptional. Frequently prejudices are not recognized as false or unsound assumptions or stereotypes, and, through repetition, become accepted as common-sense notions.

Privilege

The experience of freedoms, rights, benefits, advantages, access and/or opportunities afforded some people because of their group membership or social context.

Discrimination

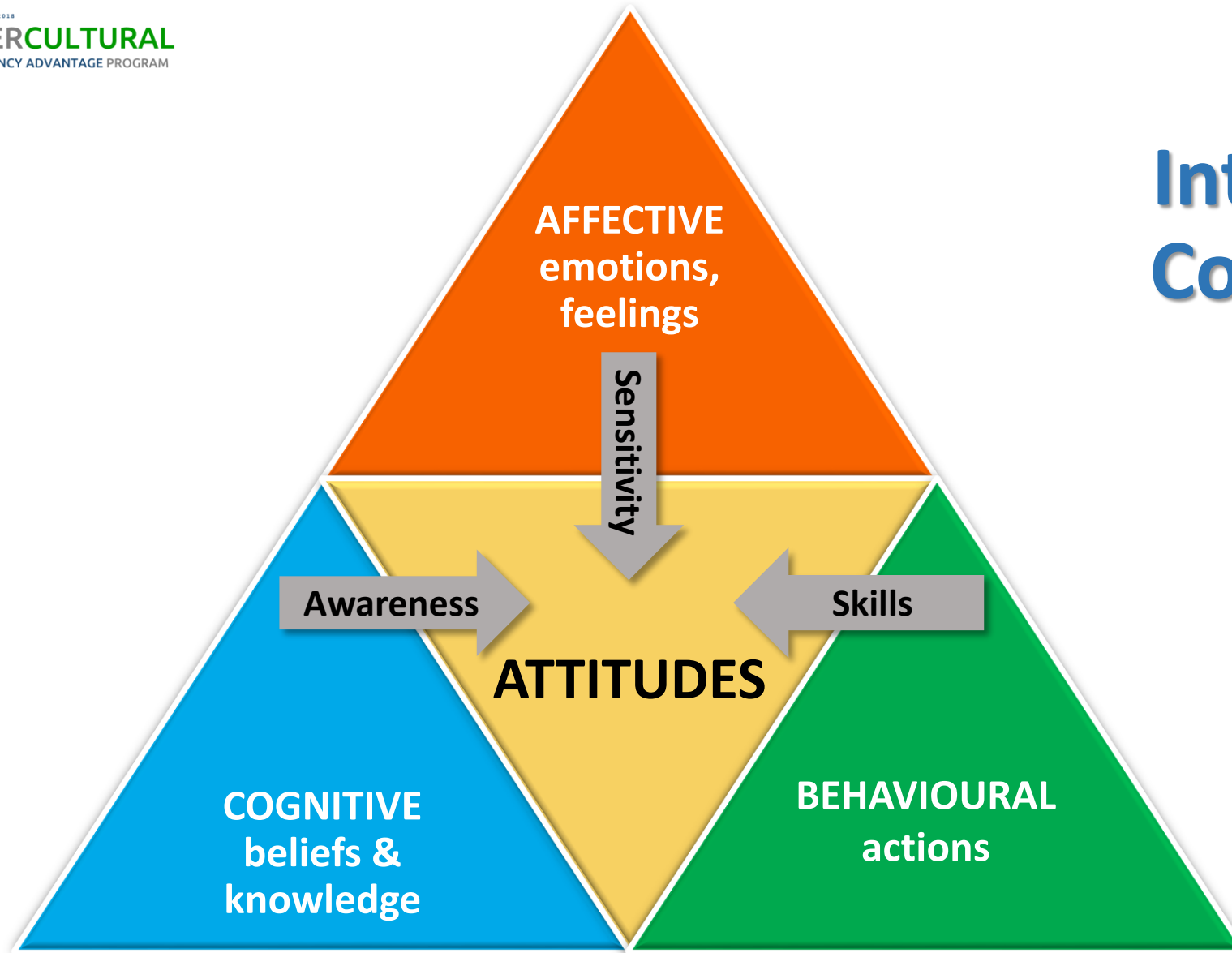
The denial of equal treatment and opportunity to individuals or groups because of personal characteristics and membership in specific groups, with respect to education, accommodation, health care, employment and access to services, goods and facilities. Behaviour that results from distinguishing people on that basis without regard to individual merit, resulting in unequal outcomes for persons who are perceived as different. Differential treatment that may occur on the basis of race, nationality, religion, ethnic affiliation.

Intercultural Competency

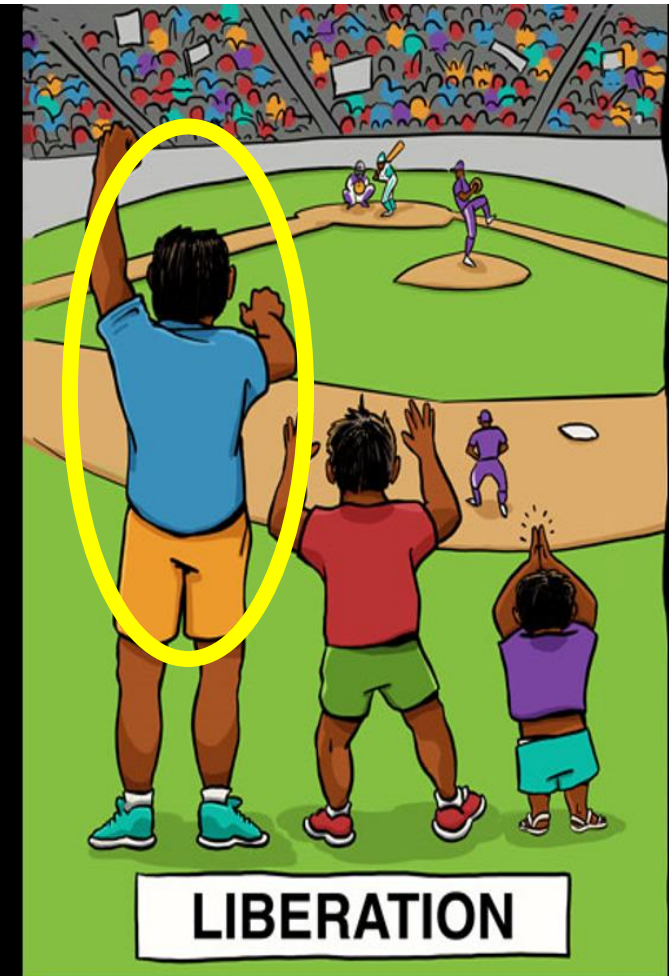
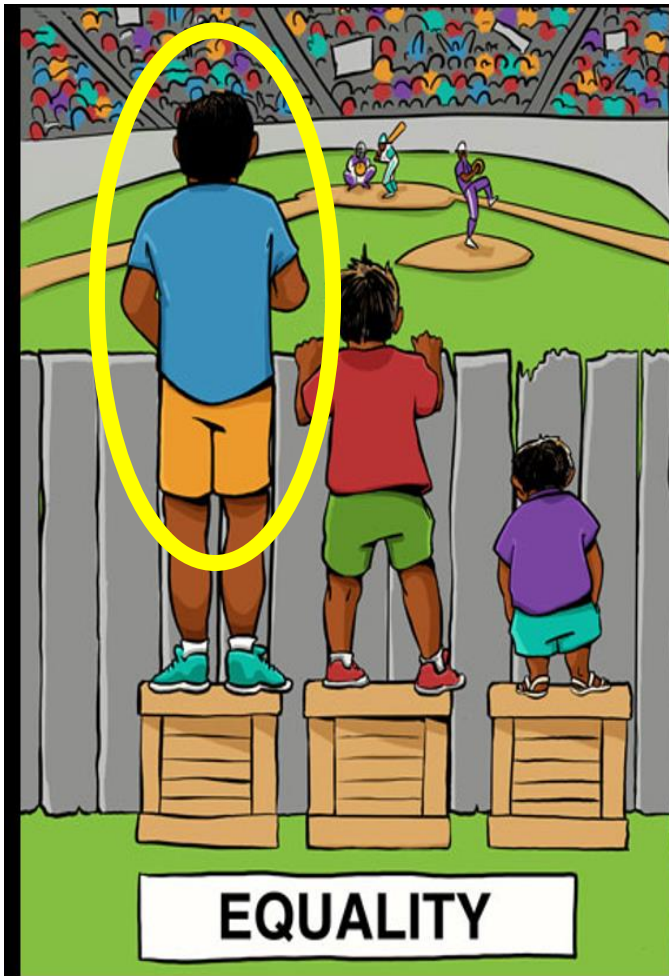
Intercultural competency is a set of **knowledge, feelings, and skills** that enable a person to communicate, work and function effectively in pluralistic contexts.

It involves increasing one's own **sensitivity about differences** in values, beliefs and behaviours, and **developing skills to determine** the most appropriate practices and behaviour to communicate and **work effectively** and respectfully across cultures.
